

### **Bettendorf Community Schools**

Working with students considered at-risk due to home or school situations, or lack of positive role models as a Lunch Time Buddy or after school in the Homework Club.

Time Commitment Needed: 1-4 times per month (lunch) or Weekly (Homework Club)/1 school year

Type of Setting: School

### **Davenport Community Schools-STAARS Mentoring Partnership**

Working with at-risk youth during lunchtime (school based) and after school at a faith based site for tutorir mentoring (site based).

Time Commitment Needed: 1 hour/month for school based/for 1 academic year minimum

2-hours/month minimum for site based/ for 1 academic year minimum

Type of Setting: School & Church

### ***Denkmann Elementary***

Reading to students or listening to students read and homework assistance.

Time Commitment Needed: 30 minutes or more M, T, W, F/for one year

Type of Setting: School

### ***Frances Willard Elementary School***

Working with K-6 grade students to practice reading and math skills.

Time Commitment Needed: ½ to 1 hour weekly/for 1 year

Type of Setting: School

### ***Garfield Elementary School***

Working with at-risk youth from single parent families that need a positive influence.

Time Commitment Needed: 30-45 minutes a week/for one year

Type of Setting: School

### ***Jane Addams School***

Tutoring K-6 grade students involved in the BASE (Building Academic Success for Everyone) Program who struggle with academics and do not receive special education help.

Time Commitment Needed: ½ to 1 hour every week/for one-school year.

Type of Setting: School



***Neil Armstrong Elementary***

Working with K-5 grade students considered at-risk which may include academically, socially, emotionally and/or economically as Lunch Buddies, Homework/Study Club, and Reading/Tutoring partners.

Time Commitment Needed: Lunch Buddy Program at least 2 times per month but weekly is encouraged/for one school year

Homework Club one time a week/for one school year

Type of Setting: School

***Pleasant Valley High School***

Working with 9<sup>th</sup> grade at-risk students.

Time Commitment Needed: 45 minutes per session/for one semester

Type of Setting: School

***Pleasant Valley Community High School***

Working with at-risk, special education and regular education students who need direct experiences with successful adults.

Time Commitment Needed: 45 minutes per day/for 1 semester starting in January 2008

Type of Setting: School

***Roosevelt Elementary School***

Working with students on reading, flashcards and homework, etc.

Time Commitment Needed: ½ hour or more a week/for one year or more

Type of Setting: School

***Silvis School District # 34***

Working with low achieving students.

Time Commitment Needed: Flexible

Type of Setting: School



### **Scott Community College**

Mentoring opportunities with students:

*TriO Student Support Services Program*-provide support and encouragement to students in developing and pursuing educational goals.

*Journalism students involved in the SCC student newspaper*-provide a mentoring relationship in regards to the field of journalism.

*Newly elected Student Government/ Phi Theta Kappa leaders*-provide a mentoring relationship in regards to leadership experience.

Time Commitment Needed: Varies/for one semester

*Work with children in Kids Club* after school program to enhance a child's education.

Time Commitment Needed: 1 ¼ hours/1 school year/Wednesdays and Thursdays

Type of Setting: Church

*High Energy Youth Group* built to serve God and learn His Word.

Time Commitment Needed: TBA/1 school year

### **Christian Friendliness**

Christian Friendliness' main goal is to bring Hope of Christ to the hurting kids and teens in our community. One of the ways we do this is by small groups and mentors. A mentor or small group leader will have the chance to impact and bring hope to one to five kids or teens in our centers.

Time Commitment Needed: Evening clubs are 2 hours long/6 months to 1 year

Type of Setting: Youth Center

### **Young Life Quad Cities**

College and adult leaders will help plan and lead club and help with a Bible Study. Will also take kids to camp in the summer.

Time Commitment Needed: Once a week

Type of Setting: Various settings

### **Arrowhead Ranch**

Working with youth at-risk with issues in community acceptance and reintegration.

Time Commitment Needed: TBD/6 month commitment

Type of Setting: Agency



### **Child Abuse Council – U.D.I.S. Program**

Tutoring teenage youth ages 13 – 17 in math, English, etc.

Time Commitment Needed: 4:00 – 6:00 p.m./Mondays and Tuesdays/year round program with youth in program 6 months

Type of Setting: Agency

### **Scott County Juvenile Court Services**

Working with young people without good family support.

Time Commitment Needed: 1 hour a week/one year

Type of Setting: Agency

### **Gilda's Club**

Spend quality time with children and teens in play area, playing games and engaging in activities.

Time Commitment Needed: 2 hours per evening/open to mentor's time

Type of Setting: Agency

### ***JA of the Heartland***

Teaching JA classes in schools – grades K-12

Time Commitment Needed: One semester

Elementary Classes – 1 hour a week for 5 weeks during school year

Middle School – 1 hour a week for six weeks during school year

High School – 1 hour a week for 7 weeks during school year

Working with children who are academically at-risk.

Working with/mentoring youth involved in LSI's youth engagement activities to get them involved with positive adult and peer role models.

Time Commitment Needed: Flexible weekly activities/1 school year

Type of Setting: Schools, Churches, Community Centers

### **Lydia Home**

#### **Tutoring and homework help for elementary through teens**

Time Commitment Needed: School year - 3:30 – 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday/1 school year;

Summer program – 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday

Type of Setting: School

**Tutoring and one to one mentoring for Lydia Urban Academy High School students**

Time Commitment Needed: Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Type of Setting: School

*Teaching life skills and one to one mentoring for young mothers at Ruth Services Maternity Home*

Time Commitment Needed: Daily – flexible scheduling.

Type of Setting: Residential Maternity Home

**Project Renewal**

Help youth with homework, interact with youth through recreation and social activities.

Time Commitment Needed: Flexible, Monday through Friday - 3:00 – 5:00 p.m., occasional evenings and holiday parties

Type of Setting: Neighborhood home

**World Relief – Moline**

Tutor refugee children or families of children; help with problem-solving, homework, English acquisition and engage in inexpensive fun.

Time Commitment Needed: 3 hours per week/9 months to 1 year or longer

Type of Setting: Client's Home, Library, Park

**American Red Cross of the Quad Cities Area**

Mentors youth who are members of Red Cross youth clubs at area schools.

Time Commitment Needed: 1 hour, 1 to 2 times per month/1 school year

Type of Setting: School, Church, Agency

**Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Quad Cities Area**

One-to-one mentoring.

Time Commitment Needed: 2 – 10 hours per month/ for one year

Type of Setting: School, Church, College Campus, Community Building

**Boy Scouts of America**

Working in school and after school learning for life programs.

Time Commitment Needed: 1 to 2 hours per week/ for one school year

Type of Setting: School, Neighborhood Houses, Church

**Girl Scouts of Eastern Iowa and Western Illinois**

Working with girls in short-term programs; after school outreach programs to bring the Girl Scout program to girls.

Time Commitment Needed: Flexible/1 year

Type of Setting: different settings and locations in the QC area

**Spend time talking to and rocking infants and toddlers during busy lunchtime**

Time Commitment Needed: 3 months

### **Help 6 to 12 year olds with homework and or play board games**

Time Commitment Needed: two hours a week/Tuesdays and Thursdays/for one school year

Type of Setting: Day Care Center

Work with youth in YMCA before and after school programs.

Time Commitment Needed: Two hours a week/Monday through Friday/3:00 – 5:00 p.m./for one school semester
